

### TAKIS MARTHAS


Studied architecture in the Polytechnion of Athens and since 1960 has been Professor of Drawing there. Since 1952 he has contributed to exhibitions in Athens.


T. MARTHAS: Geometrical composition I. 1964. Oil. 57 × 80 cm.

### PARIS PRECAS



P. PRECAS: Don Quixote, 1965. Oil, 180 x 69 cm.


